One of the wackier dance crazes to hit the U.S. (ha) in recent years is the *Freefall*, inadvertently invented by Esther and Ruby Pringler one evening last January as they attempted to break into their sister-in-law's Miami Beach apartment. Although exceedingly improvisational, the Freefall accurately demonstrates the unencumbered falling motion of a body that is subject only to the earth's gravitational field, one of the four Fundamental Interactions of Nature and the one most likely to give the performer contusions and abrasions.
