Le Tour de France doping scandals weren't limited to the late 20th and early 21st century. Otto Pringler and Giuseppe Dinklaker, two riders in the very first race in 1903, were disqualified because (1) their bicycles' front wheels were too big by 800 percent, (2) they refused to wear their team's cerulean Spandex jerseys with the dancing hula girl tassels, and (3) both mistakenly rode Stages 7 through 12 in the wrong direction, earning them the title of Certifiable Dopes.
